EMERGENCY ROOM

Asthma attack (severe)

Bleeding that won't stop

Broken bone (looks bent, curved or deformed)

Fever (infants less than 2 months old)

Head injury (loss of consciousness or extreme impact)

Miaraine

Pneumonia (diagnosed, with worsening symptoms)

Poisoning

Seizure

Stomach pain (severe)

Swallowed object

Trouble breathing

When to call 911

If you think your child's life is in danger, call 911.


Potentially life-threatening situations may include:

- Choking or extreme difficulty breathing (anaphylaxis concerns)
- Loss of consciousness, severe confusion, or unable to awaken
- Seizures
- Bleeding that does not stop
- Burns to the head or neck
- · A child who is threatening to harm themselves or others

Children's Mercy Urgent Care does not provide:

- Routine physicals
- Sports or work clearance exams
- Reproductive health care
- Foster care placement exams
- Care for those beyond their 18th birthday
